Remote Learning

Dear Parents and Carers,

First of all, huge thanks for the quick adaptations you all made to the sudden announcement of school closures and also for all the messages of encouragement and support – they are very much appreciated.

I just wanted to write to you with regards to remote learning. As I have previously mentioned, there is a much greater expectation from the government that all children who are not in school are engaging in remote learning. At the moment, we do not know how long schools are going to be closed, therefore it is vital that children continue with their learning and complete **all** the work set by school and that they don't just complete the easy tasks. There is a suggestion of around 3 hours per day. All teachers are working hard to upload work as well as preparing classrooms and teaching critical worker and vulnerable children therefore it is disappointing when children do not engage.

Whilst we understand that there are many challenges around home learning, we urge you to encourage your child to complete as much work that is set as possible. Each day, there will be maths, English and other topic activities uploaded onto Seesaw into the activities. These should be completed and then returned to the teachers for feedback. We are trying to link this as closely as possible to the work which is being set in class. Teachers will feed back on the work which is returned. It may be good for your child to have a routine to your day if this works for you and your family (although we do understand that it is often hard to juggle your own work with your children's). e.g.: 9:00-10:00- Maths

10:30- 11:30 – English 1:00- 2:00 – Other/Topic 2:15-2:45 – reading/times tables/spellings

If you do not have access to appropriate devices, please could you let us know as we may be able to arrange the loan of some equipment once this arrives from the government. If you have difficulty accessing the work and require a learning pack, please do request one. These must then be returned at the end of each week for marking. We will do all we can to assist you with this.

Where work is not being completed, after two days of incomplete work, we will call to see where we can support you further.
