Dear Parents and Carers

I just wanted to follow up from my messages last night following the announcement that all schools should move to remote learning from today. School will be open for critical workers and vulnerable children today. Thank you very much for all the messages of support, they have been very welcome.

All other pupils should access remote learning through the Seesaw app. There is an expectation that your child completes the work which is set. Each day, there will be maths, English and another subject uploaded.

We will be monitoring this carefully and calling home to offer any support which may be needed. If you do not have a device and are unable to access Seesaw or if you need a paper copy of work, please do let us know and we can make this available to collect from tomorrow. We would prefer to avoid this option where possible in order to prevent cross-contamination. Please do only communicate with your child's teacher either through Seesaw or by contacting the school office.

If your child is in receipt of benefits-related free school meal, they are entitled to attend school and a meal will be provided. Where they are not attending, we will initially provide a grab bag. This week, we will provide a 'grab bag'.

Do not hesitate to contact us if you have any queries or concerns, as always. We know that these are very testing times and are always happy to discuss any concerns you have.
