

Summary of home learning offer 11<sup>th</sup> Jan 1.1

It would be most helpful if each weekday, children could log on to Seesaw and register – there will be a morning message from the teacher in the form of a note. Your child will be asked to add an emoji or a simple ‘hello’ underneath the note, then we will know that they are accessing the work. Whilst our staff will stick to these timings, one of the many benefits of Seesaw is that the work will remain on there so if it does suit you as a family to complete the work at a different time, this will not be an issue. Also, each class will have a message from their teachers outlining the structure and expectations of the day, as we are aware setting an overview of expectations is very helpful to all.

Your child will be set work daily (outlined below). It will be uploaded each morning. Teachers will keep a record of children who have been on Seesaw each day like the school register and teachers and teaching assistants will give feedback on the children’s work during the hours of 9:00 am and 3:30pm.
