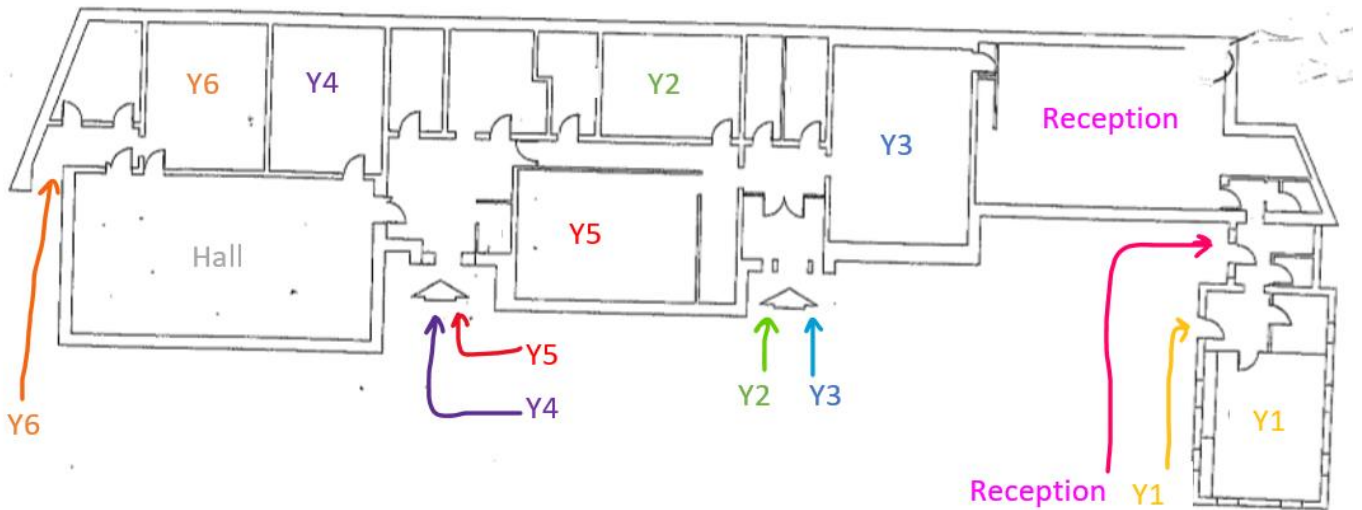
### School Day

### Extra Bank Holiday


