Dear Parents and Carers,

As I have done with parents of children across the whole school, I would like to invite parents in of children who are receiving additional support across specific areas of the curriculum.

Our SEN Governor, Paul Miller, and I would like to invite you into school on **Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> June at 2:30pm.**

Together, we can look at Bowling Green Academy's revised Special Educational Needs (SEND) provision as detailed in our Information Report, which is available on our website. The report should accurately detail the resources and staff our school can provide. If a parent, for example, is considering Bowling Green Academy as a school for their child, the statutory report should act as a descriptor of our support so they can make an informed decision. Similarly, existing parents can see the support we can offer, which is being continually updated to meet the needs of our children in school.

At the meeting we can also look at our support within school, including setting and sharing targets, Individual Education Plans (IEPs) and inclusivity.

While writing to you, I would just like to draw your attention to Calderdale's improved Local Offer website, which details all the support that the Local Authority can provide. I hope that you can attend the meeting. If you can, please let the office know. I can understand that a meeting to discuss the additional support your child receives may be daunting. The discussion will be confidential and working towards a shared interest. It should be a very helpful opportunity in looking forward about how to support children within school and help to improve our provision into the future.
