Parents/Carers can purchase uniform with logos from the following places: **Ziggy's School Wear** and **The Uniform Shop**, Halifax. Our PTA is also organising a sale of good-quality, pre-owned uniforms (keep updated via SeeSaw).

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Trousers dark grey/black school trousers or shorts

Skirts dark grey/black/navy school skirts

Dresses dark grey/black/navy pinafore dress or

blue/white checked dress

Shirt white shirt or polo-shirt, either with school logo

or plain

Sweatshirt navy, either with school logo or plain

Socks/Tights black, grey, navy or white socks or tights

Footwear should be plain, black school-type shoes

without coloured flashes or heels - see

examples below. No trainers or other similar

footwear.





Make-up it is not necessary for children to wear make-up

or nail polish.

Jewellery is not allowed, apart from a stud earring in each

ear. Children must be able to tape up or remove their own earrings for PE and swimming for health and safety reasons.
Children may wear a watch (not a smart-

watch).

Hair hairstyles must not be 'extreme' and only

natural hair colours.



PE Kit

Teal t-shirt (ideally with Bowling Green Academy logo)

Navy/black shorts or navy/black plain joggers or leggings

Optional PE hoodie

(school jumpers can be worn as an alternative)

PE pumps or sports trainers

PE kit will be worn to school on your child's PE days.
