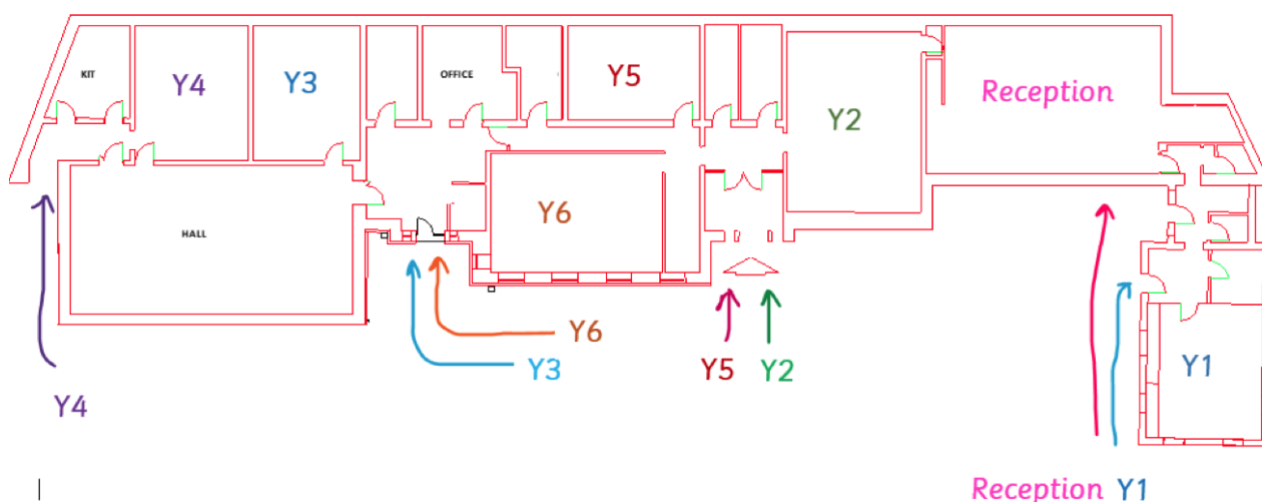
New School Year


