Strike Action - update

Dear Parent/Carer,

Regarding the proposed upcoming industrial action by teachers on 1st February 28th February, and 15th and 16th March, I am writing to you with the belief that we will have enough staff in school to remain open for all classes and are therefore likely to be staying open for all children. As a minor caveat, this is the position that I believe Bowling Green is in currently. If you have been following the news on strikes, you will be aware that things can change - for example, if a union chooses to reballot its members.

Industrial action is a contentious issue – particularly where education and/or health is involved. I am sure you would agree that no-one takes voting or makes a decision to strike lightly, and I am sure you would also agree that every member of staff here cares greatly about the best outcomes for our wonderful children.

I will continue to keep you informed if there are any updates regarding the proposed strikes. In the meantime, I hope you will be as pleased as I am that we are likely to be staying open for all our children on the above dates.
