Dear Parent/Carer,


Regarding the proposed upcoming industrial action by teachers on 1st February 28th February, and 15th and 16th March, I am writing to you with the belief that we will have enough staff in school to remain open for all classes and are therefore **likely to be staying open for all children**. As a minor caveat, this is the position that I believe Bowling Green is in currently. If you have been following the news on strikes, you will be aware that things can change - for example, if a union chooses to rebalot its members.

Industrial action is a contentious issue – particularly where education and/or health is involved. I am sure you would agree that no-one takes voting or makes a decision to strike lightly, and I am sure you would also agree that every member of staff here cares greatly about the best outcomes for our wonderful children.

I will continue to keep you informed if there are any updates regarding the proposed strikes. In the meantime, I hope you will be as pleased as I am that we are likely to be staying open for all our children on the above dates.
